Policy and Penalties:  Any Parent/Volunteer that does not abide by the policies listed in this form will be subject to penalties. In efforts to be fair we have created a process which will help protect the Parent/Volunteers in the event they make a mistake or violate the agreement in any way. First violation will result in a written warning delivered via email. Second offense will result in a Program Directors Probational meeting/hearing. Third violation will result in revoking the status of the Parent/Volunteer until the following season where the Program Director will review and make a discretionary decision whether or not to reinstate that Parent/Volunteer. In the event that any Parent/Volunteer is ejected from any contest due to unethical behavior, they must have a meeting/hearing with the Program Directors to discuss the nature of the offense prior to attending any future practices or contests.
